- o Employees working between 50% and 74.9% time equivalency will receive earned benefit time equal to 50% of a fullime employee.
- o Employees working less than 50% ftilhe equivalencymay qualify for personal leave but will not be eligible for sick or vacationearned benefit time.

Vacation, sickand personal leave accrue om anthly basis. Employees are eligible to "borrow" against these leaves in advance of their accrual throughout the current fiscal year.
