Aservice arinal (nocetification required) is defined as a degerminist use hose that is individually trained to do work or perform a task for the benefit of a person with a disability, induring a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. Emiliaral support/comfort animals (prescription required) or the apychys (training and certification required) are not considered service animals under Title II of the ADA and are generally not permitted on campus. Students who wish to request to have a more service animal on campus must neet with the Director of Disability and Testing Services prior to bringing anamimal on campus. Service arinals may have access to any public space on campus where the harder is allowed to go Aservice arinal may be restricted from certain areas of the College if it presents as a fety concerns for others

College personnel struktigive aservice arimal and its handler access to activities, events, and company property. In the event it is not apparent that the service arimal is trained to perform a task(s) for its handler; personnel may only ask the following questions of the handler:

- 1. Is the arinal required because of a disability?
- 2 Wratwarkartask(s) is this arimal trained to perform?
